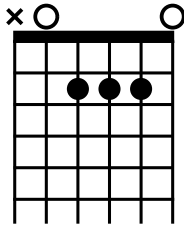


A MAJOR SHAPE BARRE CHORDS

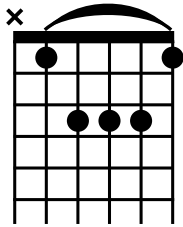
A MAJOR



IF YOU USE YOUR 2ND, 3RD AND 4TH FINGERS TO MAKE AN A MAJOR CHORD SHAPE, YOU CAN MAKE ANY MAJOR CHORD BY SLIDING YOUR FINGERS ALONG THE FRET BOARD AND PLACING YOUR FIRST FINGER ACROSS ALL THE STRINGS BEHIND YOUR FINGERS.

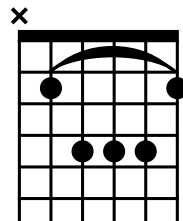
THE NOTE ON THE 5TH STRING WHERE YOUR FIRST FINGER IS MAKING THE 'BARRE' GIVES THE CHORD ITS LETTER NAME.

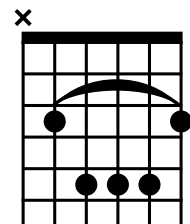
FIRST FINGER ACROSS

SECOND FRET - B MAJOR

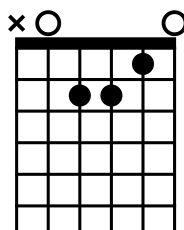
C MAJOR

THIRD FRET - C MAJOR

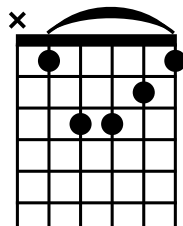
A MINOR SHAPE BARRE CHORDS

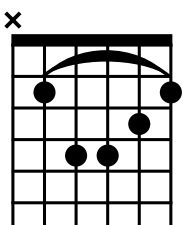

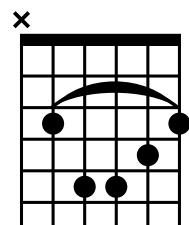
